- **Back-to-School: Hair Affair:** In preparation for the first day of school, the Berwick Area United Way teams up with local hairstylists to provide Berwick Area School District students with fresh, clean haircuts in hopes of eliminating this financial burden and boosting students' confidence. The first year we scheduled 40 appointments, followed by 82 the second year. In 2024, we provided 155 students with FREE haircuts!
- Berwick Farmers Market: Open 7am-12pm on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays from July to October, the Berwick Farmers Market offers goods from local crafters, artisans, and farmers. SNAP, WIC, and Senior Vouchers are accepted. Interested vendors can contact Monica at maz4markets@gmail.com.
- Literacy Kits: Literacy Kits are distributed to children ages three to five. They contain a variety of fun learning activities designed to support letter and number recognition, counting, and recognizing patterns and provide caregivers tools to support a child's language, literacy skills, and creative thinking.
- Little Free Pantries: These pantries, stocked with nonperishable foods, hygiene products, and warm clothing, are located around Berwick and available for anyone in need, anytime.
- **Rested & Ready:** The initiative is an effort to help school-aged children get off couches or floors and into a warm, clean bed. Consistently getting a good night's sleep is imperative for school success. 89 beds have been distributed to Berwick Area School District students to date.
- **The Nurse's Pantry:** Available in all Berwick Area School District buildings, this in-school supply provides clothing, hygiene items, and wellness products to meet immediate student needs and reduce absenteeism.

- Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA): This program provides free income tax return preparation to limited income families. 1,205 returns were completed for the 2023 tax year, returning \$1,258,571 to area residents and saving \$212,080 in tax return preparation fees. Appointments begin in January.
- **Book Drive & Distribution**: Elementary students choose books of their interest, within their reading level, to begin building at-home libraries. The free book distributions are held in late spring to encourage students to read over summer break and avoid the "summer slide."
- **Dolly Parton Imagination Library**: Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is a book gifting program that mails free, high-quality books to children from birth to age five, no matter their family's income.
- **Read Across America Day**: Read Across America Day promotes reading for young children. United Way volunteers enter all elementary classrooms, to read books and to discuss the importance of reading with students.



Youth programs:

- **BSA Learning for Life with Guest Lecturers (Career Exploring)** A program of the Columbia-Montour BSA, which offers middle school and high school students the opportunity to engage guest speakers from local industry in hands-on, interactive, and immersive career exploration experiences.
- Classroom on "Main Street" Held in the downtown shopping districts of Danville, Berwick, and/or Bloomsburg, PA this program exposes high school students to the different skills required to start up and run a business. Students tour a variety of local businesses and hear from owners/managers about how they started and continue to run their businesses.
- **S.E.A.L. Challenge** A STEM program which partners with the U.S. Department of Defense and Penn State's Applied Engineering Lab to offer curriculum to local school districts and to provide the materials for Columbia and Montour County students to compete to build either a land rover, a drone, or an underwater vehicle.


